







- The best thing for us is not what we consider best, but what the Lord wants of us






Bakhita Stars





Kindergarten-Half day programs

The classroom is where students learn and explore ideas together while working towards the Kindergarten curriculum.

The teacher plans and develops lessons and will teach the curriculum to the whole class as well as in small groups and 1-on-1.

The classroom teacher creates meaningful learning opportunities by setting targeted learning goals for the children to work towards achieving.

The teacher assesses the children's understanding and reports on the student's achievements to parents/caregivers including formal reporting.

Play-based opportunities take place throughout the Kindergarten Program to support the student's natural curiosity as they begin to understand the curriculum being taught.


